

SEED VARIETY NAME OR BLEND OR MIX NAME

Pure Seed

Listed by % by weight. In mixes, the higher % must be listed first on the tag.

Other crop

Listed by % by weight. Crop seed could be contaminants. If number is high, ask to see the test. If 5% or higher, must be specified on tag

Inert Matter

Listed by % by weight. Broken seed, chaff, dirt, empty florets, dead seed etc.

Weed Seed

Listed by % by weight. Many are controllable but some are not. **Noxious weeds** are determined by state and must be labeled if found. States with UGS (undesirable grass seed) laws require listing here.

Lot Number

An identification number that is unique to the lot, or mixture for tracking purposes

Germination

Provides the buyer with an indication of what % of the seed in the bag are live and vigorous. The **test date** is indicated because germination rates drop over time. Most states require test to be within 9 months of sale.

Origin

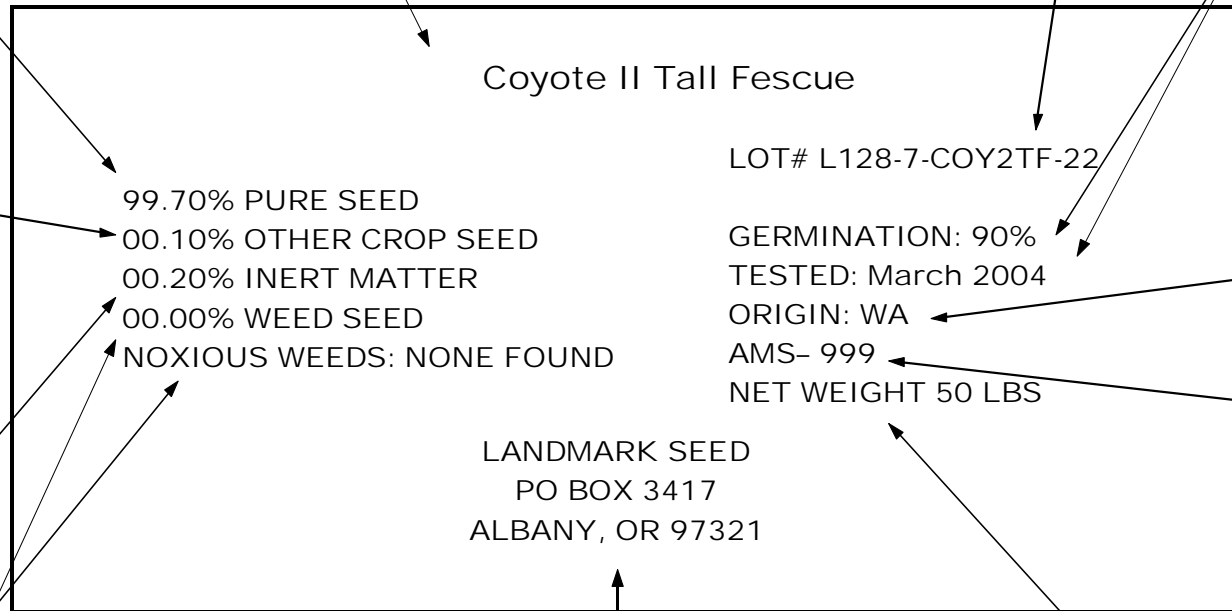
State, or country where seed was produced

AMS Number:

USDA- Agricultural Marketing Service identification of the packager/producer of the seed.

Net Weight

Total wet of contents. Pounds of actual seed.
